Division Specifications

Leadline: Open to riders 7 & under. Riders may not cross enter into any trot class. To be judged 50% on equitation and 50% on suitability of mount.

Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation: Open to riders 10 & under. Judged on equitation. Riders may not cross enter into any canter or jump class.

Short Stirrup Equitation: Open to riders 12 & under. Riders may not cross enter into class with jumps higher than 18". Courses may be trotted.

Long Stirrup Equitation: Open to riders 13 & older. Riders may not cross enter into class with jumps higher than 18". Courses may be trotted.

Short Stirrup Hunter: Open to riders 12 & under. Riders may not cross enter into any other VHSA Associate division except Pleasure and VHSA/BHSA Eq. on the Flat. No rider may ride more than 2 mounts.

Courses may be trotted.

Student Equitation: Open to riders in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences 2' or higher. Judged on equitation. Courses may be trotted.

Adult/Junior Hunter Pleasure Horse – Open to all horses. To be judged on manners, suitability, soundness & way of going.

Hunter Pleasure Pony: Open to ponies ridden by juniors. To be judged on manners, suitability, soundness & way of going.

VHSA/BHSA Equitation on the Flat: Open to Juniors and Adult Amateurs. May be split into Juniors 14 and under, Juniors 15-17, and Adult Amateur.

Maiden Hunter: Open to horses & ponies in their 1st year of showing over fences 2' or higher. No restrictions on riders. Courses may be trotted.

Limit Rider Hunter: Open to horses and ponies ridden by juniors and adult amateurs who are not entered in any classes jumping 2'6" or higher. Riders ineligible for Equitation OF. Horses may cross enter.

Low Hunter: Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders.

Pony Hunter: Open to ponies 14.2h and under ridden by juniors only. Fences for Small at 2'; medium at 2'3"; large at 2'6".

Green Pony/ Green Hunter: Open to horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences 2'6" or higher and ponies in their 1st year of showing at 2', 2'3", 2'6" or higher. Ponies to be ridden by juniors.

VHSA/BHSA Pony Equitation: Open to juniors on ponies. Judge may call back at least 1/4 of class for flatwork. (see Pony Hunter heights.)

Thoroughbred Hunter: Open to horses who are registered with or are eligible to be registered with the Jockey Club. No restriction on riders.

Children's/Adult Hunter: Open to Juniors and Adult Amateurs mounted on horses only.

VHSA/BHSA Children's/Adult Equitation: Open to Juniors and Adult Amateurs on horses. Judge may call back at least 1/4 of class for flatwork.

Working Hunter: Open to horses/ponies not entered in a Pony Division.

Rules & Info

- ASTM/SEI certified helmets must be worn by ALL Riders when mounted. Proper attire is required.
- In extreme heat, jackets may be excused at the Judge's discretion.
- The Judge's decision is always final.
- Classes follow rules and specifications set forth by the USEF, VHSA and BHSA.
- Six ribbons will be awarded in each class. Champion & Reserve ribbons will be awarded for each division.
- Each entry must present a signed release waiver and an open check to receive a back number.
- All ages are as of December 1, 2023
- All horses/ponies on show grounds must present a PHYSICAL COPY of a negative Coggins test taken within one year.
- \$50.00 will be charged for returned checks.
- Points will be counted according to the VHSA/BHSA point system.
- Show management reserves the right to refuse entries, change officials and combine/cancel/split classes if necessary.
- Dogs must be leashed at all times.
- Exhibitors show at their own risk.
- Bull Run Hunt Club, Locust Hill Stables, and any officials or employees or agents will not be held responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to any exhibitor, spectator, groom, property, or animal at the show.
- Participants and spectators alike understand that horses are inherently unpredictable and dangerous, and that equipment and ground conditions are equally unpredictable; and knowingly choose to participate and/or spectate, taking full responsibility for this choice. Entry onto the grounds constitutes knowledge and agreement with this policy.
