Rules & Information

ENTRY FEES: \$20.00 per class. \$20 per warm up. Unjudged rounds \$20. For any questions related to this show, or weather please call 804-761-6182.

COGGINS TEST: All exhibitors must present a negative Coggins Test report taken within one year on each animal exhibited. This is a Virginia State Law. Please bring an extra copy to leave with the show office.

ATTIRE: All exhibitors must wear ASTM/SEI protective helmets with harness fastened at all times while mounted on the show grounds. Boots and breeches/jodhpurs required with either polo shirts, riding shirts or jackets.

AWARDS: The judge's decisions are always final. Six ribbons per class. Champion Ribbon and Reserve Champion Ribbon in each division.

Division Specifications:

California Warm-up: Unjudged. Will run all day.

Cross Rail Jumper: Open to horses and ponies. Horses and ponies may only cross enter into Puddle.

Puddle Jumper: Open to horses and ponies. Horses, ponies and riders may only cross enter into any class not exceeding 3' if otherwise eligible.

Novice Jumper: Open to horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing in Jumper classes at 2'6" or higher as of Dec. 1st of the current show year. Horses and ponies in this division may only cross enter into classes not exceeding 3'.

Novice Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper: Open to horses and ponies ridden by juniors and adult amateurs in their 1st or 2nd year of showing in Jumper classes at 2'6" or higher as of Dec. 1st of the current show year. Riders may only cross-enter into classes not exceeding 3'.

Open Jumper: Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders.

Low Jumper: Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. May be combined with TB Jumper.

Thoroughbred Jumper: Open to registered Thoroughbreds and those eligible to be registered.

Junior/Adult Amateur Jumper Equitation: Open to juniors and adult amateurs. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance, control and optimum time. Numerical scoring.

Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper: Open to horses and ponies ridden by juniors and adult amateur riders. **Schooling, Modified Jumpers:** No restriction on horses/ponies or riders.

- Class 1 & Class 3, will be scored under USEF Table IV1-Optimum Time First Round.
- Class 2 & Class 4 will be scored under Table IV2b, Time 1st J/O, Optimum Time.
- The first class of each division except Cross Rail & Puddle will be scored under USEF Table II 1- Time 1st Round. (Classes 5, 7, 9, 11, 14, 16, 18, 20.)
- The second class of each division except Cross Rail & Puddle will be scored under USEF Table II, Section 2(b) Time first jump-off. (Classes 6, 8, 10, 12, 15, 17, 19, 21.)
