If you have ever had a question about anything hunt related, please send it in to Miss. Appropriate.

Dear Ms. Appropriate: I understand the overall utility of members carrying a hunt whip, but it's a handful! What about juniors and ladies? -All Thumbs

Dear Thumbs: Carrying a whip is optional, but it's a useful way of keeping hounds from being kicked by your horse (which is an offense) by quietly dropping the whip quietly on the side of the horse. They should not be used in any other way to control hounds. Leave that to the

Since carrying some sort of whip is necessary for disciplining your horse anyway, it's not a big leap to carry one with a thong (the long, braided piece). If you start by carrying one while hacking out, you'll quickly get used to it without the added pressures of the hunt field. Ladies' whips are more slender than a gentleman's. Juniors may carry one one if they can do it safely.

They also come in handy when reaching for a chain over a gate or a dropped glove. Other useful skills to practice at home!
